PUMPKIN PIE CAKE

29 oz. can pumpkin (make sure the can says Pumpkin, not pumpkin pie)
4 eggs
13 oz. can evaporated milk
1 ½ cups sugar
2 tsp cinnamon
1 tsp ginger
½ tsp nutmeg
1 box yellow cake mix
1 cup melted margarine
1 cup chopped nuts

Beat all ingredients together except cake mix, margarine, and nuts. Put in ungreased 9 x 13 cake pan. Sprinkle dry cake mix over mixture. Pour melted margarine over cake mix and then sprinkle with chopped nuts. Bake 350 degrees for 1 hour. Top with cool whip if desired.
